On Friday, July 10, 2020, the New York State Department of Health issued all skilled nursing facilities rules, about how to implement on-site family visiting again, to the residents. The Parker Jewish Institute is currently analyzing and drafting a policy, based upon the many rules issued to us, about family resident visiting.

Some of the rule high-lights are:

A facility is full compliance with all State/Federal Requirements	✓
Testing the residents for COVID-19 continues	✓
Testing the staff for COVID-19 continues	✓

When approved, only 10% of the residents, may be allowed visitors, at any one time. We are hoping by Friday, July 17, 2020, to have a draft visiting policy/more details available, to all of our Parker Families.
