Dear Parker Families,

In an effort to ensure the safety of our Parker community and per our COVID-19 Management Plan, the following policy will be implemented for the safe return of visitors for our residents. To continue to ensure appropriate Infection Control and to minimize any transmission risk, the following guidelines are in effect:

1. The Facility has entered Phase 4 in the community.
2. The Facility has been COVID free for 28 days, with stable staffing ratio.
3. The Facility attests that the Nursing Homes is in full compliance with all State and Federal requirements, State Executive Orders and guidance, State reporting requirements; including COVID-19 Focus IC Survey, HERDS and staff testing surveys, as well as federally required submission of COVID-19 data to the National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN).
4. All of our Residents have been tested for COVID-19 virus, per policy.
5. All of our Staff have been tested and testing continues weekly with directives for immediate furlough for any staff members who may test positive.
6. All of our Staff and Residents continue to be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID virus daily.

In order to begin onsite visiting, Parker must be COVID-19 free (both staff and patients) for 28 days. Based on our daily results, we may be able to begin visitation, as early as the week of August 31, 2020. ***Subject due to change as per regulatory guidelines.***
