In an effort to keep our families engaged with their loved one's life – especially at this time when visitation has been challenging, due to the uncertain times we live in – we are proud to announce the creation of the Parker Shares Smiles program!

The mission of the Parker Shares Smiles program is to support/assist the residents within the building, their designated family members and to afford the opportunity to share photos via Dropbox.

At Parker, the highlight of our day is when we see our community members smile – we know that would make your day too! We want to share that with you. We plan to kick off this program on Friday, October 2, 2020.

The ParkerSharesSmiles Program Procedure:

- 1) Please E-Mail a request to: ParkerSharesSmiles@parkerinstitute.org and include the following :
 - Your Name
 - Email
 - Phone Number
 - Name of Parker resident/patient
 - Room Number
- 2) Our Therapeutic Recreation staff will obtain photo release forms from residents who are capable of giving consent. For those unable to consent to photographs, Therapeutic Recreation staff will contact the family to obtain consent.
- 3) The Therapeutic Recreation staff will photograph residents participating in the program weekly.
- 4) Therapeutic Recreation staff will ensure that all individual's rights with regard to privacy is being adhered to.
- 5) Therapeutic Recreation staff will upload photos to the HIPPA compliant file hosting service of Dropbox. Each participating resident will have an individual file.
- 6) Designated Therapeutic Recreation staff will e-mail one resident photograph per week to one family member via Dropbox. The designated family member must download the photograph to his/her person device prior to sharing with other family members; families may not share via Dropbox.
