Breaking News: Parker Jewish Institute Receives COVID-19 Vaccine

Parker Jewish Institute is pleased to announce that it received Pfizer's COVID-19 vaccine. In New York, skilled nursing facilities received the vaccine today, Monday, December 21, 2020, for patients, residents and staff. Parker is partnering with Walgreens, one of the approved pharmacies, to administer the vaccine. This process requires two doses that are at a minimum provided 21 days apart.



“We are extremely optimistic about the vaccine,” said Michael N. Rosenblut, Parker’s President and CEO.

“We are confident that the vaccine, with its efficacy rate of 95 percent, will mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and ensure the safety and well-being of our most vulnerable population. The COVID-19 vaccine offers a ray of hope in that it may enable families to finally reunite in-person.”
