Dear Parker Family Members and Friends,

As of today, we have identified two staff members who have tested positive for COVID-19. All residents and staff members will continue to be tested for COVID-19.

At this time, as per our regulatory guidelines, we are suspending indoor visitation effective immediately, until further notice. We will continue to host outdoor visitation, weather permitting for all units not effected by this restriction. You will be contacted by a member of the team if the unit your loved one resides on is effected. Compassionate care visits will continue to take place.

Please be sure to follow these rules when visiting:

Wear a mask, with face shield or goggles, from when you enter our facility until you exit the building. Protective gear must be worn when in the presence of a resident, both indoors and outdoors. Wash or sanitize your hands when you enter the building, often throughout your visit and again prior to leaving.

Maintain social distancing at all times during your visit. Our obligation is to protect our community from the spread of COVID-19. Thank you in advance for your understanding and support.
