Dear Parker Family Members and Friends,

Parker Jewish Institute is contacting our community members to announce that we are now administering the COVID-19 booster shots, to those who qualify.

The Pfizer booster is available to people who received two doses of the Pfizer vaccine, at least six months ago and who meet one of these qualifications:

- They are 65 or older
- They are between 18 to 64 years old, and either have an [underlying medical condition](#) or a higher risk of COVID-19 exposure due to their job (for example, health care workers) or where they live or frequently visit (for example, a homeless shelter)
- They are living in a nursing home or other long-term care facility

The third Pfizer dose is intended to help many people boost their immunity from the initial vaccination series.

Parker is offering appointments for the Pfizer booster, [which can be scheduled here](#). Those receiving the booster must bring proof of age, identification, vaccination card and their insurance card.
