Dear Parker Family Members and Friends,

We have identified six staff members and three residents, who have tested positive for COVID-19. These team members are removed from the facility. Parker remains open for visitations.

At this time, with the infection rate rising significantly, we ask that you strongly consider scheduling an [outdoor visit](#) in our heated outdoor pavilion, and/or, scheduling a [virtual visit](#). We remain vigilant in enforcing our infection control protocols, and ask that if you choose to visit in the facility, that you maintain all infection control practices in place, for the health of our residents, staff and for you and your family.

Please be sure to follow these rules when visiting:

Wear a mask from when you enter our facility until you exit the building. Protective gear must be worn when in the presence of a resident, both indoors and outdoors. Wash or sanitize your hands when you enter the building, often throughout your visit and again prior to leaving.

Maintain social distancing at all times during your visit. Our obligation is to protect our community from the spread of COVID-19. Thank you in advance for your understanding and support.
