Dear Parker Family Members and Friends,

We have identified one resident, who has tested positive for COVID-19. Parker remains open for all indoor visitations.

At this time, based upon current community infection rates, we ask that you always consider scheduling an [outdoor visit](#) in our heated outdoor pavilion, and/or, scheduling a [virtual visit](#). We remain vigilant in enforcing our infection control protocols, and ask that if you choose to visit in the facility, that you maintain all infection control practices in place, for the health of our residents, staff and for you/your family.

Please be sure to follow these rules when visiting:

Wear a mask from when you enter our facility until you exit the building. Wash or sanitize your hands when you enter the building, often throughout your visit and again prior to leaving. When entering the Parker Jewish Institute, please have your "negative" COVID-19 test with you, or, you may test at the Parker Lobby, if more convenient, when you arrive.
